## Cinzel Typeface:

“Cinzel is an uppercase typeface, similar to Trajan and Michaelangelo, but available in six weights” (FontSwan). The weights are regular, medium, semi-bold, bold, extrabold, and black. Cinzel has all capital and small capital letters. It is belonged to serif family. It also has Cinzel decorative.

## Identifying Characteristics:

- Cinzel has a bit of contrast and x-height. Cinzel font is a bit of geometric and seems openness.
- It has no italic or lower case
- Bottom of **J** and **Q** are baseline
- Top and bottom serifs on most letters
- **E** has long lower arm
- It has pointed apex and vertex.
- Some decorative letters have top and/or bottom swash look like this **À W Z V**

The Cinzel and Cinzel Decorative fonts designed by a Portuguese citizen and a Typography teacher, Natanael Gama. “Typeface inspired in first century Roman inscriptions, and based on classical proportions. However it’s not a simple revivalism, while it conveys all the ancient history of the Latin alphabet it also merges a contemporary feel onto it” (Fontsquirl). The fonts were released in 2012.

Classy-looking Cinzel font works well for posters, writers, and publishers. Elegant-looking Cinzel Decorative font is good for stylish text, branding name, and web that gives calligraphic appearance. Both fonts’ bold and black are for striking effect.

The fonts became popular fonts from logo makers because the fonts are all capital letters, sleek, and contemporary.
